## KINGMAN DISTRICT'S LARGEST RECOVERY PROJECT COMPLETE NEARLY SIX MONTHS AHEAD OF SCHEDULE

**KINGMAN** – The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) is putting the final touches on the \$5.8 million US 93 Southbound Ranch Road Project. The project was awarded in mid-July of this year, and will finish nearly six months ahead of their June 2010 contract completion date. ADOT saved nearly \$1 million when Ames Construction bid the project under ADOT's estimate.

The US 93 Southbound Ranch Road Project is located 17 miles north of Wikieup boasting a new two-lane southbound roadway and improvements to existing US 93, which now carries two lanes of northbound traffic. In the coming months, crews will complete the off-roadway features, which include the final landscape establishment and completion of minor box culvert work.

These improvement efforts are part of a greater effort in improving the US 93 Corridor to a four-lane divided highway from Wickenburg to Interstate 40. The first segment spanning 36 miles, from Wikieup to Santa Maria, was completed in February 2008. US 93 Southbound Ranch Road was the first construction project to begin along South US 93 this year.
